Police and Sheriff's Patrol Officers maintain order by enforcing laws and ordinances. They perform a variety of duties, including directing traffic, investigating accidents, making arrests, or working in courts.

Police & Sheriffs perform the following tasks:

- Working directly with the public.
- Resolving conflicts or negotiating with people.
- Operating vehicles or equipment.
- Collecting information from different sources.
- Identifying information by categorizing, comparing, or detecting changes in circumstances or events.
- Making decisions or solving problems.
- Communicating with supervisors, co-workers, or people that work under you.
